The Burial Ground is primarily for the use of those members of the Religious Society of Friends who are members of the following Area Meetings:

1. Chilterns
2. London West
3. North West London

Permission may be granted for the use by members of other Area Meetings, by attenders and by non-members. Such permission (which is given sparingly) should be sought from the Advising Friend or the Clerk.

There are 3 different ways of using the Burial Ground:

1. Full interment of a coffin
2. Interment of a casket of ashes
3. Scattering of ashes

Please note: Only the first two qualify for a headstone.

Applicants for the use of the Burial Ground should make contact with the Advising Friend as soon as possible, who will be able to give advice on steps to be taken.

Having established that the deceased is eligible to use the Burial Ground, you will be asked to complete the Burial form (JBG2), and also the Headstone form (JBG3) if you wish to have a headstone. Both are available for download from the website or from the Advising Friend, and should be completed in duplicate, one copy to be retained by you and the other to be returned to the Advising Friend.

CONTRIBUTION TO BURIAL GROUND MAINTENANCE COSTS

No charge is made for members of the three Area Meetings, CAQM, LWAQM and NWLAQM. For members of other Area Meetings, attenders and non-members, a single contribution is asked for as follows:

Interment of coffin	£400
Interment of ashes	£200 (Note additional to digging charge)
Scattering of ashes	£100
